1. Introduction

Welcome to DOX. This Privacy Policy explains how DOX collects, uses, stores, shares, and protects information obtained from users of the DOX platform, including websites, applications, services, events, communications, and related offerings.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect personal information, organization information, opportunity information, payment-related information, communications data, and technical information such as IP addresses, device information, browser information, usage patterns, and analytics data.

3. Personal Information

8. How We Use Information

Information may be used to operate the Platform, manage accounts, verify organizations, facilitate communications, improve services, personalize experiences, provide recommendations, conduct analytics, prevent fraud, maintain security, comply with legal obligations, and support business operations.

9. AI and Recommendation Systems

DOX may use automated technologies, algorithms, and artificial intelligence systems to recommend opportunities, organizations, events, content, and connections. Such recommendations are informational only and do not constitute endorsements.

10. Legal Basis for Processing

Where applicable, information is processed based upon consent, contractual necessity, legitimate business interests, legal obligations, protection of rights, security interests, and other lawful bases.

11. Information Sharing

DOX does not sell personal information. Information may be shared with service providers, payment processors, analytics providers, cloud hosting providers, security vendors, legal authorities, and parties involved in business transactions such as mergers, acquisitions, reorganizations, or asset transfers.

12. Public Profiles and Visibility

13. Organization Verification Data

DOX implements reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. No system can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

19. Marketing Communications
